## MAKING LIBRARIANS 'VISIBLE' IN A 'VIRTUAL' WORLD PPM-LAS COMMEMORATIVE CONFERENCE

6-8 April 2005 Hotel Istana Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

Organised by the Librarians' Association of Malaysia to celebrate the joint 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Persatuan Pustakawan Malaysia (PPM) or the Librarians' Association of Malaysia and the Library Association of Singapore (LAS).

The advent of ICT and the consequent 'invasion' of Internet had created a virtual world that brought unprecedented changes and challenges to the way the world operates and interacts.

ICT has brought new ideas and new depths to the traditional domains of education, communication and management giving rise to concepts such as globalisation, knowledge management (k-management), e-learning, e-economy, e-government, information literacy, etc. ICT too has made lifelong learning a reality by providing multiple access to education through various non-traditional pedagogical strategies.

For library and information professionals, how more revolutionary can it be when the library as they know it to be has now



evolved into the Digital Library, with collections and services no longer bound by the physical barriers of time, space, distance, form or format. How more daunting can it be when the knowledge and skills that they have developed over the years are no longer sufficient or relevant in the light of the new developments. The emergence of the 'Digital Library' has made it incumbent upon library and information professionals to review their roles, upgrade their skills, update their knowledge and empower themselves with not only high-order technical and professional competencies but also learn to operate in a

Even though everyone seemed to be tired after the long flight and being a way from home for a week, but that did not stop them from venturing Bangkok in the wee hours. Some even extended their stay in Bangkok for 2 nights. Participants arrived back in Kuala Lumpur on 18 December 2004.

## Google Is Adding Major Libraries to Its Database

Google, the operator of the world's most popular Internet search service, plans to announce an agreement today with some of the nation's leading research libraries and Oxford University to begin converting their holdings into digital files that would be freely searchable over the Web.



It may be only a step on a long road toward the long-predicted global virtual library. But the collaboration of Google and research institutions that also include Harvard, the University of Michigan, Stanford and the New York Public Library is a major stride in an ambitious Internet effort by various parties. The goal is to expand the Web beyond its current valuable, if eclectic,

body of material and create a digital card catalog and searchable library for the world's books, scholarly papers and special collections.

Google - newly wealthy from its stock offering last summer - has agreed to underwrite the projects being announced today while also adding its own technical abilities to the task of scanning and digitizing tens of thousands of pages a day at each library.

Although Google executives declined to comment on its technology or the cost of the undertaking, others involved estimate the figure at \$10 for each of the more than 15 million books and other documents covered in the agreements. Librarians involved predict the project could take at least a decade.

Because the Google agreements are not exclusive, the pacts are almost certain to touch off a race with other major Internet search providers like [Amazon](#), [Microsoft](#) and [Yahoo](#). Like Google, they might seek the right to offer online access to library materials

"Within two decades, most of the world's knowledge will be digitized and available, one hopes for free reading on the Internet, just as there is free reading in libraries today," said Michael A. Keller, Stanford University's head librarian.
